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**ORDER APPROVING FINAL APPLICATIONS FOR
COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

Upon the final fee applications (the "Final Fee Applications") under 11 U.S.C. § 330 filed by the professionals (the "Professionals") listed on Schedule A attached hereto and retained in the Chapter 11 cases of The Christian Brothers' Institute and The Christian Brothers of Ireland, Inc., as debtors and debtors in possession (the "Debtors"), seeking an order awarding final compensation and reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses; and the Final Fee Applicatoins having come before this Court on March 19, 2014 (the "Hearing"); and due and sufficient notice having been given pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(a)(7) and (c)(2); and due consideration having been given to any responses thereto and the agreements set forth on the record regarding the amended amounts sought and sought to be paid by the Debtors' estates; and upon the record established at the Hearing; and sufficient cause having been shown therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Final Fee Applications are granted to the extent set forth in the attached Schedules A and B; and it is further

ORDERED, that as set forth on the record of the Hearing regarding the allocation of payment of the fees allowed hereunder, the Trust created under the Debtors' confirmed plan of reorganization is authorized to and shall pay (i) \$85,753.00 of Tarter Krinsky & Drogin LLP's final fee award hereunder, (ii) \$230,000.00 of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP's final fee award hereunder, and (iii) \$60,000.00 of The Law Offices of Paul A. Richler's final fee award hereunder, notwithstanding any other provision of the Final Fee Applications or Schedule A

hereto; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Debtors are authorized and directed to pay the final fee awards and reimbursement of expenses allowed hereby minus (a) the amount set forth in the prior decretal paragraph and (b) all prior payments made pursuant to the Court's monthly compensation order and interim fee order, as set forth on Schedules A and B attached hereto; and it is further

ORDERED, that this order constitutes a separate order with respect to each Final Fee Application.
