

NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS AND CREDITORS:

FAQs re FILING OF PROOFS OF CLAIM

There seems to be some confusion about the requirements and process for the filing of Proofs of Claim. The following is a list of answers to frequently asked questions concerning Proofs of Claim:

Question: Do I have to file a Proof of Claim?

Answer: Yes, if you want to receive any distributions from the PFG Bankruptcy Estate. EVERYONE MUST FILE a Proof of Claim in order to participate in any distributions from the PFG Bankruptcy Estate.

Question: Did the Interim Distribution made by the Trustee to Vision Financial Markets LLC ("Vision") on account of futures accounts mean that I don't have to file a Proof of Claim?

Answer: The Interim Distribution to Vision was separate from the Proof of Claim process. Even if your account was one of the ones that were transferred to Vision, only a portion of your potential recovery was part of that Interim Distribution. In the future, the Trustee expects to make additional distributions to customers, and you MUST FILE a Proof of Claim in order to be eligible to receive those further distributions. No further distributions will be made by the Trustee to Vision.

Question: If I had futures, forex and metals accounts with PFG, do I need to file a separate Proof of Claim for each such account?

Answer: Yes. You must file a separate Proof of Claim for each of your 4d, 30.7, forex and metals accounts.

Question: When is the DEADLINE for filing Proofs of Claim?

Answer: The Bankruptcy Court has extended the previous deadline (November 16, 2012) for filing proof of claim forms.

The new DEADLINE is December 14, 2012.

Question: To where should I send my Proof of Claim?

Answer: The Bankruptcy Court has ordered that all Proofs of Claim are to be filed with the Trustee electronically online at www.pfgchapter7.com or sent to the Trustee's claims agent via certified mail, return receipt requested, at Peregrine Financial Group, Inc., C/O Rust Consulting/Omni Bankruptcy, 5955 DeSoto Avenue, Suite 100, Woodland Hills, CA 91367.

Do Not mail, email or fax your Proof of Claim to the Bankruptcy Trustee's office. Please follow the above instructions.
